Not your traditional thrift store, designer consignment boutiques like My Girlfriend's Closet in Temecula carry gently-worn name brand clothing at a fraction of their original price. Not only are consignment stores like MGC a great place to shop, but they're also a great place to resell your high-end labels. 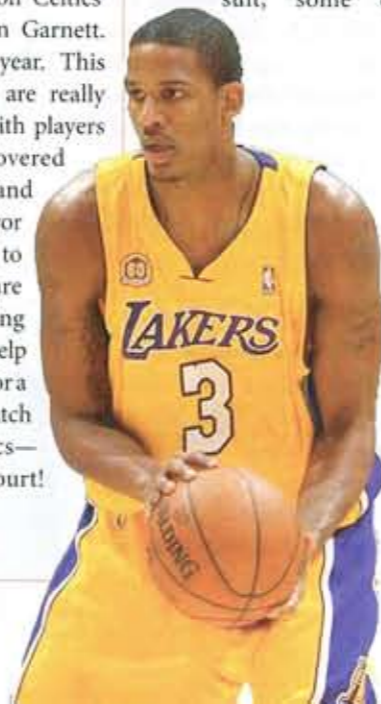

16. PHYTOLISSE

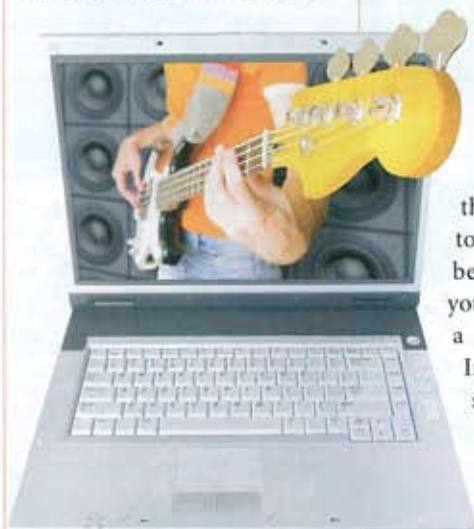
